## WHO

  2. Gain a better understanding of “Active Shooters” and how they evolve
  3. Enhance your *situational awareness* and understand your exposure
  4. Learn your limitations – mental, emotional and physical
  5. Learn the skills necessary for identifying suspicious behavior – red flags
  6. Learn how to report suspicious behavior – at home, work, the internet and social media
  7. Learn to recognize alcohol and drug abuse and other destructive behavior patterns
  8. Learn the fundamental requirements necessary for survival and helping others
  9. Learn how the Police and First responders react, respond, and
  10. Ensure you take the necessary steps for maintaining compliance and safety
